Rajah Serfoji Government College students actively took part in the Nationwide Competition on Legal Rights of Women conducted by the department of Zoology on 03.10.2018. This programme is launched and sponsored by the National Commission for Women (NCW), New Delhi last year. NCW has a view to disseminate the information on constitutional and legal rights/entitlements, etc of women. It is aimed to assess and enhance the awareness on the legal rights of women.

Around 220 students answered 75 multiple choice questions on laws related to women. Some of the topics focused on the competitions are Indian constitution, Major international conventions related to women, Acts pertaining to National Commission for Women, Dowry Prohibition, Protection Women against Domestic Violence, Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace, Maternity Benefit Act.
