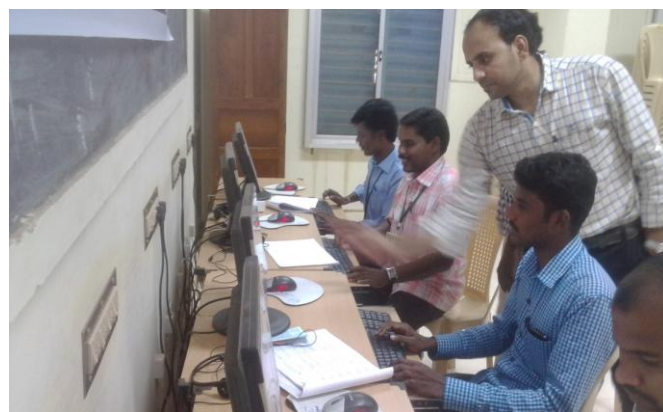


Validation workshop on Corpus Based Dictionary

The PG & Research Department of English, Rajah Serfoji Government College (Autonomous), Thanjavur-5, Tamil nadu had organized a three day workshop on **Corpus Based Dictionary** from 27th-29th January 2014 in collaboration with LDCIL, **Central Institute of Indian Languages, Mysore**. Professors and Research scholars from the department of Tamil and English of various Institutions participated in that workshop and worked on Corpus Based Dictionary Creation. In continuation of that workshop, a Validation workshop on Corpus Based Dictionary from 7th-13th January 2015 was organized in collaboration with LDCIL, Central Institute of Indian Languages, Mysore.



This workshop brought together the lexicographers and language experts from all over India to work on manually built resources. This workshop also intended to validate the dictionary in view of improving the language resources. The linguists were comfortable with the tasks such as checking lexical entries and analyzing. The computer scientists were familiar with formalization. The workshop offered an opportunity of interaction which is required to overcome problems in the preparation of corpus based bilingual dictionary. It is planned to publish the dictionary in 2016 after carrying out the correction done by the language experts and lexicographers who participated in the workshop.
