In the G.O. first and second cited above, the Government have accorded sanction to create Soft Skill Centres in 62 Government Colleges. The Government also sanctioned Rs.2 lakhs as seed money (non-recurring) and Rs.2.5 lakhs (recurring). Accordingly, 30 and 32 Soft Skill Centres were created in Government Colleges during the academic year 2013-14 and 2016-17.

In the G.O. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> cited above, the Government have sanctioned for Rs.1,55,00,000/- recurring expenditure for creation of soft skill centres in 62 Government Colleges for the year 2021-22. Now the Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education is releasing of Rs.2,50,000/- for each college for the year 2021-22.

I request you to follow the guidelines strictly to spend the amount. The receipt of the DD bearing No.130853667 dated: 06-04-2022 for Rs.2,50,000/- may be acknowledged with stamped receipt.

## GUIDELINES

**Sub:** Guidelines for Implementation of Soft Skills Training in 62 Government Arts & Science College – Reg.

\*\*\*\*\*

As per G.O. (Ms) No.5 Dt.19-01-2013 and G.O. (Ms) No.111 Dt.9-5-2016 TANSCHÉ has been conducting this programme in 62 Government Colleges. As Colleges have started functioning post COVID-19 in the regular mode, funds for Soft Skills training is being released for the 62 Government Arts & Science Colleges. The following guidelines may be used for the implementation of Soft Skills training for 500 III year UG students of the College from the recurring grant of Rs 2.50 lakhs:

- This programme is to be conducted without affecting the college working hours particularly it should be conducted only after college hours.
- A trained faculty member may be appointed as Coordinator for the Soft Skills programme. A sum of Rs.3000/- may be paid as honorarium to the Coordinator.
- A sum of Rs.17,000/- may be set aside from the 2.50 lakh for purchase of toner, stationery, and other overhead charges and Rs.5,000/- may be paid to a administrative expenses.
- 500 students from III year UG programme may be selected for Soft Skills training. If needed II year UG students may be included in the training programme.
- Soft Skills training in Communication Skills, Personality Development, Presentation Skills, Language skills, CV/Resume writing and facing interviews may be conducted.
- Trainers may be identified from within the college, Corporates / soft skill trainers outside the college may be engaged as resource persons to impart training to students.
- An amount of **Rs. 400/-** (one hour) may be paid as honorarium to the trainers per session. 400 sessions x 500 students (**400 x 500 = 2,00,000**) may be conducted in April, May, June, July 2022. The training may be completed before 31.07.2022.
- The attendance of the student participants and that of the Soft Skills trainers (within college and from corporates) may be submitted in the attached format along with original vouchers, receipts, and Utilisation Certificate to reach Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education on or before 07.08.2022 without fail.
